PlainsCapital Bank is hosting interns for our Summer 2022 Internship Program. Internships will be available in several of our key markets to students who meet the criteria outlined below.

Our internships are focused on commercial credit analysis. Our interns work closely with our credit analyst teams and benefit from hands-on learning in a small group environment. Candidates also gain exposure to many aspects of banking, including commercial lending, commercial credit, treasury management, and wealth management. Interns will have the opportunity to meet and interact with local leadership and banking teams, making new contacts—and often friendships—in the process.



Details

Internship positions are available in 2022 in several of our key markets across the state of Texas. We offer flexible internship start and end dates to accommodate school calendars.

Part-time and full-time availability as well as the number of positions will vary by location. Part-time interns can expect to work approximately 20-25 hours per week while full-time interns can expect to work approximately 40 hours per week, both generally Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. We also offer time off for vacation or travel approved in advance. Housing and transportation are not included with the internship and are the responsibility of the intern.

To be eligible, you must be enrolled in a four-year program, be in good standing with your university and pursuing a degree in finance or accounting. Openings and instructions for applying will typically be posted directly with your university. We will conduct formal interviews and you will need to be available to interview at your desired internship location.
